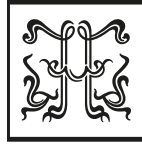

“Europe a view from Inside” By Rudy Aernoudt



“Europe is neither a deus ex machina nor a scapegoat, but it can make a real difference for the European Citizen in certain areas. The European citizen is the real stakeholder of the European (hi)story. Europe must focus on those areas where it can really make a difference for the Citizen. Let’s be pragmatic. Based on his rich experience, Rudy Aernoudt, currently senior economist at the European Commission, offers us an in-depth and unprecedented analysis of the functioning of Europe and the challenges it faces. With a direct tone and without taboos, he identifies the “12 labour's of Hercules” necessary to reform the European Union in a pragmatic way, from the internal market to climate issues via re-industrialisation.

As Rudy Aernoudt points out in this book, “Europe is a phoenix. The deeper the crisis, the more opportunities arise. The institutional crisis led to the single market project, the banking crisis led to the banking union and the recent health

crisis made possible what had never worked before: the issuance of European bonds and accelerated the movement of re industrialisation of Europe. In other words, it is a bit as if Europe could only be born and evolve thanks to crises. This book reasons as an optimistic message in the face of the new crisis that Europe is currently experiencing with the situation in Ukraine.
